Name and address  A settlor must be an independent person. The primary role of the settlor is to settle the trust and has no right to capital or income and cannot be a beneficiary as a consequence of being a settlor. The settlor can be a company or an individual.	s
<u>Trustee</u>	
Name and address  The Trustee holds the trust property for the benefit of the beneficiaries.  The Trustee can be a company or an individual/s.	
<u>Appointor</u>	
Name and address  The appointor has power to appoint or remove the trustees. The appointor's consent is required before the trustee can exercise certain powers under the deed. The appointor is a very powerful and important position.	
<u>Beneficiary</u>	Considered Demodrations in a second on
Name and address  Beneficiaries are the individuals or entities that may have entitlement to capital or income of the trust.	Specified Beneficiary is a person or entity that is specifically named as a beneficiary of the trust;  Excluded Beneficiary is a person or
<b>Corpus Beneficiary</b> includes grandparents, parents, siblings, children, stepchildren, grandchildren, nieces and nephews, cousins etc.	entity that has no beneficial interest or has been excluded from receiving benefit under the trust.
